PRESIDENT MAHAMA TO EMBARK ON THE RESETTING GHANA TOUR OF THE VOLTA REGION

Ho, Ghana | 15 July 2026

The National Democratic Congress (NDC), Volta Regional Secretariat, is pleased to announce that His Excellency John Dramani Mahama, President of the Republic of Ghana, will undertake a two-day working visit to the Volta Region from Thursday, 16 July to Friday, 17 July 2026, as part of his nationwide Resetting Ghana Tour.

The visit underscores the President's unwavering commitment to engaging directly with the people of Ghana, inspecting the progress of ongoing government projects, commissioning completed infrastructure, and interacting with key stakeholders to accelerate socio-economic development and improve the quality of life of citizens.

The tour also provides an opportunity for the President to listen to the concerns of residents, assess development priorities firsthand, and reaffirm the Government's commitment to inclusive governance, accountability, and sustainable national development.

Day One – Thursday, 16 July 2026

During the first day of the visit, the President will:

- * Perform the sod-cutting ceremony for the 24-Hour Economy Market at Juapong, a flagship initiative aimed at promoting round-the-clock commercial activities, creating employment opportunities, and stimulating local economic growth.
- * Inspect the newly completed 1,500-seater Multipurpose Assembly Hall at the Peki College of Education, which is expected to enhance teaching, learning, and institutional events.
- * Inspect ongoing strategic road infrastructure projects, including: the Asikuma–Anyirawase Road; and the UHAS By-pass and Anyirawase–Ho Road, to assess the progress of works and reaffirm Government's commitment to improving road connectivity within the Region.



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- * Inspect the Multipurpose Laboratory Project at the University of Health and Allied Sciences (UHAS), Sokode Campus, as part of Government's efforts to strengthen health education, medical research, and scientific innovation.
- * Participate in the Free Primary Health Care Programme Durbar at the Ho Municipal Hospital, where Government's commitment to expanding access to quality and affordable healthcare services will be highlighted.

Day Two – Friday, 17 July 2026

On the second day of the tour, the President will:

- * Inspect the current state of the Ho Sports Stadium as part of efforts to improve sports infrastructure and promote youth development.
- * Hold a Resetting Ghana Citizens' Engagement at the Ho Technical University. The interactive forum will bring together residents of the Volta Region, traditional authorities, students, religious leaders, civil society organizations, members of the business community, and the media to discuss Government policies, receive public feedback, and strengthen citizen participation in national development.
- * Commission the newly completed Akatsi North District Police Headquarters at Ave-Dakpa to enhance security, improve policing services, and strengthen law enforcement within the district.
- * Conclude the regional tour with an inspection of the Ho–Denu Road Project, one of the key road infrastructure projects intended to improve transportation, facilitate trade, and enhance connectivity within the Volta Region.

The Volta Regional Secretariat of the National Democratic Congress encourages all residents of the Region to actively participate in the scheduled activities and join the President in reaffirming the Government's shared vision of sustainable development, inclusive economic growth, improved public service delivery, and accountable governance.

The Government of President John Dramani Mahama remains steadfast in its commitment to delivering transformational infrastructure, expanding access to quality healthcare, improving educational facilities, strengthening national security, creating sustainable employment opportunities, and enhancing road connectivity across the Volta Region as part of the broader Resetting Ghana Agenda.
